

Bush To End Ban On Persons Immigrating to U. S. Infected With AIDS, Leprosy, VD

WASHINGTON, DC (AP) - The Bush Administration has served notice that it intends to lift rules that prohibit foreigners with AIDS, leprosy or any of the five venereal diseases - including gonorrhea and syphilis - from entering the United States.

The new policy, Health Secretary Louis Sullivan said, will "bring us in line with the best medical thinking, here and abroad.

After consulting with medical experts, administration officials concluded the new policy would not pose an additional AIDS risk to Americans because the human immunodeficiency virus, which causes acquired immune deficiency syndrome, is not spread by casual contact. The same reasoning applied to the other diseases being removed from the disqualification list for visitors and immigrants.

"The risk of ... HIV infection comes not from the nationality of the infected person, but from the specific behaviors that are practiced, said the draft regulation of Sullivan's Department of Health and Human Services. A final version will be drawn after a 30-day period for public comment, and could be implemented in June.

HIV infection and the six other diseases have been on a regulatory list used to bar foreign visitors, workers, refugees and immigrants from entering the country. Infectious tuberculosis would be the only one to remain, because it can be spread more easily.

HIV has been the only listing that has provoked much controversy. Congress put HIV on the list of contagious diseases in 1987. But Congress and the administration came under increasing pressure from AIDS activists, medical experts and international groups last year to remove it.

Survey Shows Gay People Targets of Frequent Violence

ATLANTA, GA - One third of Gays responding to a survey reported being physically assaulted at least once because of their sexual orientation, the Atlanta Gay Center said.

Of the 36 percent of respondents who reported being assaulted, 15 percent reported being sexually assaulted or raped by heterosexuals because of their sexual orientation.

The survey said 96 percent of those responding reported some kind of verbal/physical abuse in their lifetime because of sexual orientation.

The data was collected over 12 months. Questions were published six times in *The News*, a newspaper published by the Atlanta Gay Center, and made available to people using the center's services. There were 388 complete surveys returned.

"You Are Not Alone"

Project Inform, a leading organization in the fight for effective treatments for HIV/AIDS, repeatedly emphasizes how no other disease in medical history is treated in its later stages as has been the case with AIDS over the past ten years. They argue that any disease process must be looked at early and attempts made to arrest it before there is significant damage, before there is any symptom of disease. A case in point would be breast cancer, medical science for years now have urged women at risk to practice "early detection and treatment" through self examination and tests known as mammograms to detect cancerous activity before there are any symptoms, then begin treatment. The results have been a dramatic decrease in the incidents of death related to breast cancer.

In AIDS we have known as early as 1983 that some "agents" such as AZT have an "anti-viral" (fights the virus) effect, "in-vitro" (in the test tube). After years of study on the life cycle of HIV and the effects of anti-viral therapies, researchers now confirm this early treatment logic for HIV as well. The National Institutes of Health confirmed this through studies 019 and 016 of the AIDS Clinical Trials Group in November of 1989. The results of these studies showed a clear difference between the group of HIV infected people on AZT versus those who were not. Those on treatment progressed to full-blown AIDS at half the rate as those on no treatment.

of the NIH stated that only through HIV testing could a person know if they were infected before there were any symptoms of disease.

So, we know there is treatment for HIV. Whatever we think of AZT, the bottom line is that we know there are agents that affect and slow down this virus.

But what else besides AZT can help us live with HIV? With early treatment shown to be effective the next step in this logic would be that other things as well can make a difference in the course of HIV.

Advice From Your Counselor

[In lieu of our counselor's weekly question and answer section, the Observer pays loving tribute to C. Larry Mantz, who peacefully passed from this life on February 2, 1991, following an extended condition of congestive heart failure].



C. LARRY MANTZ
March 13, 1928 - February 2, 1991

Not many readers will personally recall the days of the Royal Courts in the Gay community; nor the troubled times when Gay bars opened only after 7:00 p.m. when the entrance was always a back door; or the political era when nightly raids were conducted to arrest homosexuals and drag queens, the "criminal" element that threatened the very fiber of American society. Nor may many readers recall the names of individuals who, by their lifetime example, brought about the changes and freedoms we enjoy today. Clearly, Larry Mantz was such a man.

The traditional record would read that C. Lawrence Mantz was born in Yucca, North Dakota, served in the United States Air Force, and shortly after the service, with a cosmetology certificate in hand, made a move to New York City to pursue artistic studies. For 14 years, he owned and operated an art studio in New Orleans, worked in numerous beauty salons, and entertained thousands as the infamous impersonator, "Adrian Raintree". His stage settings for the New Orleans Musical Theatre won numerous awards, and his paintings decorate homes virtually world wide.

Once in Arizona, Larry practically re-wrote the educational system for cosmetology studies; was an instructor for noted schools including the Arizona Academy of Beauty, and became the Director of Education for the Classic Beauty Colleges. It's a record of substantial successes.

It is however, the non-traditional

Larry Mantz that changed lives. Arrested countless times for challenging fundamental prejudice, Larry was a true survivor with immovable grit. Despite Hurricane Camille, which destroyed his art studio in the 50s, with only the clothing on his back, he started over in Phoenix. Elected in 1975 as the first Epress of Phoenix, Larry was arrested for "not wearing three pieces of men's clothing", yet the following year, Adrian was honored for his stand on Gay rights by all of the Royal Courts in the United States attending a coronation in Fresno, California, and received letters of congratulations from the Mayor of Tucson and the Governor of Arizona.

He was a member of the Sons of Apollo, the Tucson Knight Owls, Los Amigos del Sol, and worked with countless Arizona public service organizations. Though he came near death in 1982, following a violent attack in his home, he started over as an author and educator, and set designer for the Academy of Performing Arts.

Though Larry was truly a gifted cosmetologist, author, artist, gardener, designer, educator, and counselor, he should be remembered equally as the most dedicated and committed friend the community could ever have had. His compassion was endless. He touched countless lives with genuine concern and generosity. His home was always open to those who needed advice, food, a chance to cry, get a healthy bug, or just share their latest adventure.

He was almost always ready to listen, parent, make phone calls to fix problems, give someone a ride, or cook another pot of stew and he possessed that special kind of courage that made him fight for what he felt was right, no matter what the odds.

Larry's family, and close friends, including Robin Prince, who shared the throne as the first Emperor of Phoenix, and his devoted roommate, Craig Scalia, after conferring with the Board of Directors at Western Interfaith Counseling Institute in Tucson, have created the C. Larry Mantz Memorial Fund, which will serve as a self-perpetuating program to provide grants, loans and scholarship assistance to troubled and/or gifted Arizona young people, assuring the Larry's gift of caring for others will continue in his name.

Last Friday, a reception/fundraiser was held for the Democratic nominee for Governor, Terry Goddard. The reception was held at the Tucson Old Pueblo Resort. Attendance for this gala event was over 300 and \$1,360 was raised to help Terry Goddard's campaign.

Also in attendance were State Representatives John Kronko, Peter Goudinoff and Marion Pickens; City Councilmembers Steve Leal, Bruce Wheeler and Molly McKasson. Also showing up was Pima County Democratic Party Chairman Bill Minette.

The guest of honor arrived at 8:00 p.m. and the throngs of people gave Terry Goddard a rousing ovation. After greeting most of the people there, Terry launched into the best speech he has given so far, in this reporter's opinion. Goddard attacked Synington regarding his business dealings and record (\$200 million in debt), and his ties to Evan Mecham. At the end of the evening, the crowd gave Terry another rousing round of applause. Terry was very pleased with the evening's events.

Friday, Feb. 8, will be a date that will go down in the annals of Tucson Lesbian and Gay history - the date that

we, as a community - have made it politically. This event was the top fundraiser for Goddard over the past weekend. There were five similar events across Southern Arizona. This did not go unnoticed. The state legislators, city council and Democratic officials were very impressed with the Lambda Democratic Caucus, and the community turnout.

After the event, Goddard informed the Lambda Executive Committee that he wishes to have one more event before the February 26th runoff election. This event will take place on Friday, Feb. 22. More details later.

To give you an idea of how impressed they are, Senator David Bartlett of legislative District 13, introduced Senate Bill 1183, "The Hate Crimes Statistics Act". This piece of legislation is similar to the federal statute that was passed in the U.S. House and Senate last year.

As a community, we have made it. We know we have the political clout to get the Lambda Planks enacted into law. We advanced the cause of Lesbian and Gay rights in the State of Arizona. To the Tucson Lesbian and Gay community, I say thank you for making this a reality.



New Attitudes About Gays In The Military

Randy Shilts, author of the best seller "And The Band Played On," about AIDS in America, is currently researching Gays in the military for a planned book.

Interviewed recently on National Public Radio, Shilts said he noticed one trend: that many commanding officers are no longer enforcing the military's unilateral ban on homosexuals serving in the military.

As is well known from many high-profile cases, homosexuals are banned from all military service. Period. No exceptions. Even having homosexual thoughts can be an offense. (A Pentagon report recently concluded there was no logical reasons homosexuals should not be allowed to serve in the military).

Part of this change in attitude stems from the current situation in the Persian Gulf. Should the fighting continue, and should the draft be reinstated (which many experts believe will never happen), Shilts said he believed many draftees would attempt to opt out of service by saying they were homosexual. Shilts further believes this would make any workable draft system impossible.

Another, more encouraging, sign was the recently announced settlement between the United States Army and Sgt. 1st Class

Perry Watkins.

Watkins' situation has been profiled in this column and in this newspaper since he was discharged in 1984 with four years left on his enlistment. Eligible for full pension benefits in 1988 (after 20 years service), the Army cited Watkins' homosexuality as a reason for his discharge. The Army had repeatedly re-enlisted Watkins even though aware of his homosexuality.

Watkins fought his discharge. The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals ruled the Army had to allow Watkins to serve out his enlistment. The Supreme Court upheld that ruling.

Last month, it was announced the Army was paying Watkins \$135,000 in back pay, upgrading his rank, and giving him full military benefits, pending a February retirement.

So you see, there is nothing wrong with being Gay or Lesbian if you give people other standards by which to judge you -- like good work. Imagine how much further along the cause of equal civil rights for Gays and Lesbians would be if we ALL stood up for them. Think about it.




