



## Jim Toevs Announces Candidacy for District 5 Congressional Post



TUCSON - Jim Toevs, political activist and local business man announced his candidacy for the Democratic nomination for Congressional District 5. The incumbent is Jim Kolbe, a Republican. Toevs made his announcement last Monday, Feb. 10 at a press conference which was followed by a talk to members of the Democrats of Greater Tucson regular weekly meeting.

The following are excerpts of Toevs' address to the press outlining his programs:

"America is in economic and social crisis -- and I want to be a part of the solution.... It is becoming increasingly clear that new faces and ideas are desperately needed on the political scene to break the paralysis in which our government now finds itself. We need men in Congress with a "can do" attitude, people who are not concerned with simply maintaining

the status quo. I believe I can make a valuable contribution as one of those people."

"Economic recovery and the creation of jobs are critical challenges facing America today.... Massive budget cuts in unneeded weapons systems would do two things: free up dollars to rebuild America's infrastructure; and offer loans to small businesses which are experiencing the most severe credit crunch since the Great Depression.

"I support tax credits to stimulate the economy and provide relief to those most hurt by the recession. Tax credits to buy homes or American automobiles, for example, would provide savings for the consumer, as well as create jobs and aid economic recovery.

"I support the enactment of universal health care legislation guaranteeing all

## Judge Strikes Down Texas Sodomy Law

DALLAS, TX - A judge here struck down the state "sodomy" law, and barred the City of Dallas and the Dallas Police Department (DPD) from using the law as a basis for rejecting Lesbian and Gay applicants. The ruling came in a lawsuit brought by Lambda Legal Defense on behalf of Mica England, a Dallas woman denied work as a police officer because of the DPD's declared policy of discriminating against Lesbians and Gay men.

Judge Larry Fuller of the Travis County District Court became the second judge in less than a year to declare unconstitutional Section 21.06 of the Texas State Penal Code, which criminalizes certain "homosexual conduct." Lambda challenged the law under the Texas state constitution, which guarantees the right to privacy and equal protection. The judge's order takes effect immediately, and means that neither the state nor the city may enforce the "sodomy" law in any way, whether in citizens' bedrooms or as a pretext for denial of employment.

"Dallas' use of the Texas sodomy statute to justify discrimination in hiring is a classic example of how these highly intrusive and stigmatizing laws harm Lesbians and Gay men, even when they themselves are not arrested or prosecuted for violating the law," said Evan Wolfson, the Lambda staff attorney.

Section 21.06, more commonly known as the Texas "sodomy" law, makes it a Class C Misdemeanor for adults to engage in consensual oral or anal intercourse with others of the same gender, even in the privacy of their own homes. Texas is one of twenty-four states (along with the District of Columbia) that still criminalizes

such private and personal conduct, and one of seven that singles out Lesbians and Gay men.

Mica England stated, "I have waited a long time for this decision, and I am delighted. I have wanted to be a police officer for many years now."

Since 1990, courts in three states have struck down their sodomy laws as unconstitutional.

## Apathy Threatens CAT Awards

TUCSON - The Community Awards of Tucson (C.A.T.) Committee, in an attempt to reconcile and reorganize itself, was dealt a defeating blow this past week. The special meeting was arranged this past Saturday evening with notices sent to all of the existing members. Due to apathy, only four of the thirty-two possible members were in attendance.

It was decided that because of the indifference and lack of concern regarding the activities of this organization, all activity would be suspended for one year. The checking account for the Committee will be placed in an interest-bearing account and held for one year. Another meeting will be scheduled in February 1993, if at that time there is still a lack of interest in the goals of this Committee, the Committee will be dissolved and the total treasury will be equally divided among the community service groups in Tucson.

The C.A.T. Committee has been in existence for a total of four years, giving recognition to many individuals and organizations of the Tucson Community for their efforts in making the Tucson area a better place for the entire Gay and Lesbian population to live.

"Bigotry of any kind is not only bad business, it is bad for business. I support the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday measure, which will be on the November ballot.

"We are experiencing the consequences of "letting George do it." Not only Democrats, but millions of Republicans and Independents as well, are looking for new leadership and a new direction. Together, we can provide that leadership and direction. It is in our hands."
